Complete rules and guidelines are below.

Video Contest Rules and Guidelines:

1. One entry per youth group. Video must be submitted by a registered group leader.
2. Videos must be recorded in high definition.
3. Your finished video must be received by Franciscan University no later than September 15, 2011 on a DVD along with the completed entry form.
4. Your finished video must be no more than 1 minute in length, no exceptions.
5. Your finished video must include at least 1 teen sharing about what Jesus did in their life during the conference.
6. All videos submitted become the property of Franciscan University's Youth Outreach and can be used at their discretion for promotional purposes.
